In the Campus documentation it states that fields for FREE and REDUCED meals are what is being sent over for the Ed-Fi field of Economically Disadvantaged.

There are more fields in the database that should send over a true for this mapping (i.e direct cert, foster care, and others). The only eligibility type processed is MEAL (free, reduced, paid, and non-reimbursable). The SES eligibility category isn't even considered, and the certification values for direct cert, foster, etc have to trigger the FARL to even be able to be sent over. Mixing food service data needs with triggers for economically disadvantaged status is not keeping in line with the latest definitions at the federal and state level for economically disadvantaged, and CEP lunch status for a district makes FARL data irrelevant.

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
