When validations are run, there are a series of messages if conflicting information is reported (for example, cannot enter an ancestry for a specific race/ethnic and then also enter decline to indicate ancestry for that same race/ethnic).

Hi John:

In Minnesota, we have just begun collecting student ancestry on some race/ethnic categories. This is in addition to collecting the Hispanic Indicator and the 5 race indicators (Am Indian, Asian, Pacific Islander, Black, White). Hmong is among the ancestries being collected.

These are held in a MN extension off the edfi.StudentEducationOrganizationAssociation called: [mn].[StudentEducationOrganizationAssociationAncestryEthnicOrigin]

There are 24 specific ancestries defined in MN shown below. 12 more are added as responses for Other, Unknown and Decline to Indicate to each of the 4 race/ethnic categories used.

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Hey Dave,

We have a new project that is spinning up and the core requirement is to be able to collect a more granular level of race information that isn't in the Federal standard. WI and MN both have large Hmong populations and we were curious if you are collecting the granularity of Asian > Hmong. If so, did you create a localized Ed-Fi extension? I already checked with Ed-Fi and there isn't a current solution in Ed-Fi core.
